I'm thinking that it might be a good idea for the Corporate Office to briefly review my documents relating to my proposed Transfer Switch installation, for the new Radio Control on the Bridge Crane at W [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] Co. in [REDACTED] IL.

Because I'm modifying the manufacturer's wiring of the Bridge Control Box and their printed wiring diagram, we might want someone at Corporate Office in Franklin to "sign off" on this installation. This is very important to me. As a representative of Crane 1, I want to do they very best I can on every job -- and with all work up to Crane 1, manufacturer, and OSHA specs.

I would very much like to get a reply on this before I return to [REDACTED] IL to do the work. And as always, I'm grateful for any & all help you, [REDACTED], and everyone else gives me.
